Celebrated for culture and ideas, Latitude Festival adds yet more names to the arts stages. With just weeks until the festival, Henham Park will be transformed into the ultimate playground of artist expression with a host of eclectic new names. Taking place 18th-21st July 2019 in the beautiful grounds of Henham Park, the festival will celebrate creativity, diversity and inspirational talent.

In the Film & Music arena Latitude attendees will have the opportunity to get inside the prophetic, angry mind of **Charlie Brooker**. The diabolical genius behind Netflix's *Black Mirror* will give an insight into the blockbuster anthology series that taps into our collective unease with the modern world exploring themes of contemporary techno-paranoia. He will be joined by *Black Mirror* co-creator and showrunner **Annabel Jones**.

In a Latitude exclusive, Actor **Russell Tovey** (Beloved for his roles in *The History Boys, Being Human, Him and Her,* and *Years* and *Years*) and gallerist **Robert Diament**, host their podcast **Talk Art** live for the very first time in The Speakeasy. Talk Art is dedicated to the world of art featuring exclusive interviews with leading creatives, and the duo have lined up a very special guest to chat to. This is not to be missed!

Russell Tovey and Robert Diament say;

"We are filled with joy and excitement to be invited to bring our Talk Art podcast to the stage for the

very first time. We set up the show last October as a way to document our friendship and passion for contemporary art. It has since grown into something bigger than we ever thought possible with tens of thousands of listeners all over the world and leading guests from the worlds of art, film, TV and music, all exploring how art can change and improve our lives. We can't wait to interview a very special guest in front of a live audience of art and music lovers!!"

The queen of reinvention **Imelda May** premieres an exclusive performance art piece in collaboration with Latitude. For the first time ever, May will open up her private world in an abstract and unique peek through the keyhole experience. **Hallowed** is a brave immersive and connective exploration of Imelda May's recent, dramatic transformation and an introduction to her great skill as a poetic story-teller. Within an illuminated reflective-cube in Latitude's secluded woodland, Imelda will welcome participants inside a sensory space to watch her write and observe her creative process both within and also 'on' her fractured glass walled environment. Supported by an immersive soundscape and emotive projected stills this unusual live project offers a unique and honest reflection of the artist through a window to a room.

Imelda May said;

""Hallowed' is a very personal project for me. I've put a lot of thought, heart and soul into it. I've delved. My reason for doing it is because I'm often asked about my creative/writing process which I find hard to describe. Art leads me. It's a quiet, calm, safe, almost sacred space for me. And, as are most artists I know, I'm both an introvert and extrovert depending on what I'm doing. So I've decided to creatively open up which naturally feels intrusive but my aim is to make it feel inclusive. I want to push my own boundaries of what's comfortable to me. Art in all its forms should never get comfortable. A little danger/change tends to lead to growth and so I hope to learn from this. Inspire and be inspired. But, as you can imagine, I'm simultaneously nervous and excited about 'Hallowed'. I'm either crazy or brave!"

The Oscar and BAFTA-winning director behind *Senna* and *Amy* returns to Latitude's Film & Music Arena for a screening of his new film **Diego Maradona** followed by a Q & A. **Asif Kapadia**'s aptitude for finding the personal face behind troubled brilliance is legendary. He made F1 gripping even for non-petrol heads in Senna, and his portrayal of Amy Winehouse in Amy was poignant and heartbreaking, and in his third film, Kapadia turns tabloid football baddie Diego Maradona into the subject of an unmissable human drama. Diego Maradona is a wild and irreverent look at one of the world's most iconic sportsmen, both on and off the pitch.

Asif Kapadia said;

"I love Latitude Festival!! I've been lucky enough to attend a few times and for me it's perfect mix of music, films, comedy, all the of the arts in one place! I'm really looking forward to presenting DIEGO MARADONA, as I did a few years ago with AMY, having a chat afterwards."

Acclaimed British documentary maker **Nick Broomfield** (*Whitney: Can I Be Me, Kurt & Courtney*, Biggie and Tupac, Marianne & Leonard) turns his attentions closer to home for his next project. At Latitude, Nick will give a special preview of his latest project **My Father & Me** an insight into his relationship with his late father Maurice. **Maurice Broomfield** made some of the most spectacular photographs of British industry, and emphasized the heroic, sublime, futuristic and sometimes surreal qualities of industry. His photographs reveal a workforce in an era of rapid transition, depicting the remnants of the nineteenth-century's industrial revolution alongside emerging modern technologies.

Celebrated poet and novelist, **Ben Okri** tops The Speakeasy literary line-up. This year Okri released his most significant and celebrated novel since his Man Booker Prize-winning Masterpiece *The Famished Road*. **The Freedom Artist** weaves together ancient myth and modern politics for an impassioned

story primed for the post-truth age; a story of love and loss, fiercely told and impossible to ignore. Fiercely political yet ferociously optimistic, Okri refuses to stop asking the most difficult questions.

Latitude's new live podcast space The Listening Post has also added a host of new live names.

The previously announced **Tape Notes** is a podcast about the art and craft of music production hosted by Radio X DJ **John Kennedy**. Each episode features an artist and producer talking about how they recorded and produced an album together in the studio, and at Latitude he's joined by the much talked about **Easy Life** before they headline The Lake Stage. The band will lift the lid on every stage of the creative process, from kindling the first spark of a song idea, through decisions on style and instrumentation, to finessing the final product.

The chart-topping podcast for the UK's best food magazine, **delicious. magazine** will also be recording two live episodes. From small producers to the best chefs in the world, from delightful dishes to the big issues in health, food waste and sustainability, from high-profile interviews to words of wisdom from the country's most thoughtful food writers, the **delicious.** podcast explores just about everything that's on the plate in 21st century Britain. In two live episodes **The Kingdom Choir** and **Grace Carter** tell producer Gilly Smith about the recipe that Tastes Like Home.

Further podcast highlights include **What Matters With Alex Reads**. Latitude attendees can join Alex as he speaks to a host of thought leaders and creatives from the Latitude bill who share personal journeys about how they embrace 'what matters to them'. And in an exclusive Latitude episode, **The Poetry Exchange** shares **Nadine Shah**'s deep and personal insights about a poem that has been 'a friend to her.'
