Meth (Methylated Spirit) stoves Fuel: Methylated Spirit	Yes	
Trangia stoves Fuel: Methanol, ethanol, isopropyl alcohol, isobutane, white gas, kerosene, jet fuel, and gasoline.	Yes	
Solid fuel stove Fuel: Solid fuel tablets	Yes	
Hexi Stove Fuel: Solid fuel hexamine tablets or pellets	Yes
